

## **Update to the temporary global surcharge for shipments originating in China – MAY 26 2020**

We recently announced a temporary surcharge on all FedEx Express and TNT International parcel and freight shipments beginning April 6.

We implemented this surcharge due to the COVID-19 containment restrictions issued in various parts of the world. Those restrictions are disrupting the global supply chain. As a result, cargo capacity is limited, and we are incurring incremental costs as we adjust our international networks to best deliver much-needed goods and services in this constrained environment.

Beginning April 27 in several regions of the world, and effective on **April 29** for most\* EU FedEx or TNT payers, the surcharge amount for most FedEx Express and TNT International parcel and freight shipments originating in China will increase from 0.9 EUR per kilo to 1.8 EUR per kilo\*. Local currency conversions apply. This increase will allow us to continue providing the best possible service to our customers during this time. This surcharge will apply until further notice.

*\* Please note the following:*

- *Countries in which the surcharge will not be implemented include Bulgaria and Greece.*
- *The effective date of surcharge will be May 13 for the following countries: France, Hungary, Russia, Slovakia, Ukraine and Portugal.*
